BEFORE THE CITY COUNCIL**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council of the City of Palm Springs, California, will hold a public hearing at its meeting of January 27, 2022. The City Council meeting begins at 5:30 p.m. in the Council Chamber at City Hall, 3200 East Tahquitz Canyon Way, Palm Springs. Pursuant to Assembly Bill 361, this meeting may be conducted by teleconference and there will be no in-person public access to the meeting location. View the City Council meeting live at the City's website at www.palmspringsca.gov/pstv, YouTube, or Channel 17 (Spectrum).

The purpose of this hearing is to consider adoption of a resolution authorizing the conversion of the current Palm Springs International Airport (Airport) \$10.00 per transaction Customer Facility Charge (CFC) to a \$9.00 per transaction day CFC (maximum 5-day limit) to finance the planning, design, and construction of a consolidated rental car facility (CONRAC) at the Airport and the design, construction and operation of the associated common use transportation system to serve the CONRAC, as needed.
