Southwest Announces Nonstop Flights from PSP to San Jose

Palm Springs, California – Southwest Airlines continues to grow at Palm Springs International Airport and has announced yet another nonstop route, adding daily year-round service to San Jose from Palm Springs.

Southwest's new San Jose service starts on Sunday, November 6, 2022, and will operate once daily on one of their 737 family aircraft. With this new route, Southwest offers nonstop service to nine airports from Palm Springs. Six routes, including San Jose, operate on a year-round basis and three operate on a seasonal basis.

"Our new daily service to San Jose brings a third northern California airport with nonstop service for our Palm Springs Customers," said [Adam Decaire](#), Vice President of Network Planning, Southwest Airlines. "This new link connects the Peninsula and Coachella Valley with the time savings, value, and Hospitality that only the People of Southwest can deliver, and underscores the kind of investment in California air travel that's made Southwest the largest carrier within the Golden State for two decades and counting."

"We're thrilled to see the continued investment in our community by Southwest," said Lisa Middleton, Mayor of Palm Springs. "Since their arrival we've seen our airport set new passenger records, add more and more nonstop options, and we now have more summer service than ever before. I want to thank Southwest for continuing to grow at PSP."

Southwest first landed at Palm Springs International Airport on November 15, 2020, and they have continued to grow ever since. Their most recent announcement, the addition of a second daily round trip flight to Las Vegas, launches next month.

Palm Springs International Airport (PSP) is owned and operated by the City of Palm Springs and is the only commercial service airport in the Coachella Valley. The airport's 13 air carriers provide nonstop service to 35 airports in

season, 30 in the United States and 5 in Canada, and 13 airports year-round. US nonstop routes include Atlanta, Austin, Bellingham, Boise, Boston, Chicago Midway, Chicago O'Hare, Dallas Love, Dallas/Fort Worth, Denver, Des Moines, Eugene, Everett, Houston, Indianapolis, Las Vegas, Los Angeles, Minneapolis, Nashville, New York City-JFK, Oakland, Phoenix, Portland, Provo, Reno, Sacramento, Salt Lake City, San Francisco, San Jose, and Seattle. Canadian nonstop routes include Calgary, Edmonton, Toronto, Vancouver, and Winnipeg. PSP is served by aha!, Air Canada, Alaska, Allegiant, American, Delta, Flair, JetBlue, Southwest, Sun Country, Swoop, United, and WestJet. Some airlines and routes operate only on a seasonal basis.
