American Airlines Adds Holiday Seasonal Service to Austin

Palm Springs, California – American Airlines is growing at Palm Springs International Airport with new seasonal service to Austin, Texas.

American's new seasonal service will operate daily November 17 – 29 and December 15, 2022 – January 9, 2023, providing Coachella Valley residents with a second nonstop option to Austin for the holidays. American will join Alaska as the second airline offering service to Austin from PSP.

"American is excited to provide nonstop access from Palm Springs to Central Texas and more one-stop connections across the airline's network this summer," said Philippe Puech, American Airlines Director of Short-Haul Network Planning. "This additional flying is in direct response to the demand we saw in 2021. We look forward to connecting customers with their family and friends this holiday season."

"We're excited to welcome additional service to Austin," said Harry Barrett, Executive Director of Aviation. "Our airport continues to offer more flight options for area residents, making it easier for them to choose to support their local airport. I want to thank American for growing at PSP."

American will operate the route on a dual-class Embraer 175 aircraft offering Wi-Fi and 12 First Class seats, 20 Main Cabin Extra seats, and 44 Main Cabin seats.

With this addition, American will offer year-round service to Dallas/Fort Worth and Phoenix and seasonal service to Chicago O'Hare and Austin from PSP. American will also return their popular seasonal Chicago service on September 9 this year, nearly two months earlier than in previous years.

Palm Springs International Airport (PSP) is owned and operated by the City of Palm Springs and is the only commercial service airport in the Coachella Valley. The airport's 13 air carriers provide nonstop service to more than 30



airports in season, and 13 airports year-round. US nonstop routes include Atlanta, Austin, Bellingham, Boise, Boston, Chicago O'Hare, Dallas Love, Dallas/Fort Worth, Denver, Des Moines, Eugene, Everett, Houston, Las Vegas, Los Angeles, Minneapolis, Nashville, New York City-JFK, Oakland, Phoenix, Portland, Provo, Reno, Sacramento, Salt Lake City, San Francisco, San Jose, and Seattle. Canadian nonstop routes include Calgary, Edmonton, Toronto, Vancouver, and Winnipeg. PSP is served by aha!, Air Canada, Alaska, Allegiant, American, Delta, Flair, JetBlue, Southwest, Sun Country, Swoop, United, and WestJet. Some airlines and routes operate only on a seasonal basis.
