Airport Job Fair to fill Over 60 Open Positions at Palm Springs International Airport

Palm Springs, California – Palm Springs International Airport (PSP) is holding a job fair to help tenants fill more than 60 open positions at the airport in preparation for the upcoming tourist season, which PSP is expecting to be the busiest on record.

A dozen companies ranging from airlines to restaurants to rental-cars are looking to fill many full-time and part-time positions. US nonstop routes include Atlanta, Austin, Bellingham, Bend/Redmond, Boise, Boston, Chicago O'Hare, Dallas Love, Dallas/Fort Worth, Denver, Des Moines, Eugene, Everett, Houston, Las Vegas, Los Angeles, Minneapolis, Nashville, New York City-JFK, Oakland, Phoenix, Portland, Sacramento, Salt Lake City, San Francisco, San Jose, Santa Rosa, and Seattle. Canadian nonstop routes include Calgary, Edmonton, Toronto, Vancouver, and Winnipeg. PSP is served by Air Canada, Alaska, Allegiant, Avelo, American, Delta, Flair, JetBlue, Southwest, Sun Country, United, and WestJet. Some airlines and routes operate only on a seasonal basis.
